

WHAT IS THE MARION NICHOLS CARING SERVICE AWARD?

Marion L. Nichols was a service provider and advocate for low-income and homeless persons in Kansas. She spent the last 28 years of her life serving the people of south central Kansas with a fierce desire to help people move from poverty to self-sufficiency through a variety of housing, nutrition, health and job training programs. Marion also served on the Board of the Kansas Statewide Homeless Coalition.

The Marion Nichols Caring Service Award was established to honor Marion's memory by recognizing Kansans with a similar passion and commitment to serve above and beyond their normal work duties. Nominees should serve in a direct service or administrative capacity to promote self-sufficiency in a non-judgmental and compassionate manner. The award will be presented at the 2018 Kansas Housing Conference: Bringing Kansas Home September 12-14 in Topeka, Kansas.
